You may choose to pay each payment with a check, however you must keep a credit/debit card on file in the event timely payment is not received. Payment plan may be dropped by written request during the year with 30 days notice. Please note, Payment Plan Option is not "monthly" payments. You are paying 9 equal payments at the first of each month.

Apparel and performance fees are additional. Costume Deposit will be due by 11/30/09, along with a signed contract. Recital Date is TENTATIVELY scheduled for June 4-6, 2010.

### Refund policy:

If within your child's first 30 days at Bounce you are not satisfied for any reason, we will cheerfully refund 100% of your tuition for your entire first term. If after your child's first 30 days at Bounce you need to withdraw, we will be more than happy to extend an account credit. Please see office staff for account credit details. # Class Descriptions:



## Youth Classes—Ages 3-6 yrs (students must be potty-trained).

### Mini Mix- I Ages 3.5-4 (30min), Mini Mix II Ages 5-6 (30min)

Your child can learn the basic fundamentals of Tap and Ballet with a bit of Jazzy fun! This class will also help with self confidence, social interaction and continue to build stellar motor skills! Level I, for the beginner, Ages 3.5 -4. Level II, Ages 5-6 or has completed I, or has had previous dance experience.

**Rhyme in Time- Ages 3-4 (30min)** - These young students can have a blast learning fun Nursery Rhymes while keeping the beat! Verbal and Rhythmic Coordination skills are introduced in this upbeat and positive class. From "This Old Man", to the silly "Coo-coo Clock", children can partake in the timeless classics and new body movements! It's a Rhyming good Time!

**Pre-Ballet- Ages 4-6 (45min)** - This class is for students choosing to learn the basics of Ballet; including body placement / alignment, learning self discipline and the start of French Terminology.

**Musicals for Mini's- Ages 4-6 (45min)** - An introduction to Musical Theatre for the younger dancer. Students will learn snippets of fun Broadway songs and silly combinations to the classic and modern musical numbers. Look out, we're using props!

## Foundation Classes

### Ballet (50min) \*Adult Ballet also available

A formal technique class based on a direct style, and using specific methods. Ballet is said to be the core foundation of most other dance genres. This is a great starting block for all kinds of performers. Ballet builds a strong core, as well as toning and flexibility. This style of dance challenges the student mentally and physically; working on discipline, confidence, and grace.

**Pointe (35min)** - Dancers learn how to dance "En Pointe", or up on their toes. Using flowing and beautiful combinations, students will learn how to simply "glide" across stage. 2-3 Years Ballet experience required. Must be enrolled in Ballet III. Entry upon Teachers' decision. Pointe Shoes/ Doctor Approval will be needed.

### Tap (50min) \*Adult Tap also available

A Rhythm based class, using formal methods of Tap Dancing. Students will learn how to hold rhythm and form sounds with the metal taps on their feet.

### Jazz (50min)

As a technique based class, Jazz style blends technique with personality. Students will learn from combinations to jumps and turns, inside practicing coronation and memory skills. Jazz has the perfect mix of focus and fun!

### Hip Hop (50min) \*Adult Hip Hop also available

A mix of Jazz and Funk together to create this fresh and energetic style of dance. Students will learn dance combinations and beginner level tricks. Be prepared to get moving, Hip Hop is an upbeat, freestyle blast!

### Break Dance & Street Tricks - Ages 8 & up (Co-ed Class) (50 min)

Acrobatics and Dance collide in this very athletic and impromptu freestyle of dance. Learn spins and slides, among exciting dance combinations. Street Tricks consist of upper body strength and balance. Coordination skills provide the base to set your freestyle identity. Learn the tricks of the trade and pop like in the videos!

## Complex Integrated/Specialty Classes

**Modern / Lyrical—Ages 12-15 (50min)** - An informal but dramatic mix of Ballet, Jazz and emotion. For Modern- Students will learn the creative methods of dance; moving the body in different ways to portray the feeling. For Lyrical- Students will be telling stories through their movements, and rediscovering the foundations of dance technique. This is a combined class for both genres. Previous dance training is recommended.

**Musical Theatre—Ages 10-15 (50min)** - Mixing acting skills with dance technique. Students can ham it up with the comedy affects, or choose to be the drama queen with a "whoa is me" type of reel. All around fun to be had! No previous dance training required, but welcomed.

**Drill Team Style (50 min)** - A high energy style of dance; that incorporates sharp movements, formations as well as team building skills. Students can learn how to move together as one while still adding their own style to the mix! No previous dance training required, but welcomed.

**Tap Troupe (45 min)** - Troupe is for the skilled "Tappers" that wish to share their love for Tap Dance with the world. Dancers will put together a one of a kind performance using props and sets, which showcase their athleticism and master skills. Hard work, but super fun! \*Audition may be required, entry upon Director Approval. \*This group may be invited to compete with the BDT.

### Scottish Highland Dancing—Ages 6 & up (50min)

Learning basic positions and movement of traditional highland dance. This contains high energy and high impact movements combining upper and lower body control. Balance and coordination is helpful. Room for possible advancement and competition.

### Mini Mix i/ii

Attire: pink or black; dance leo/dress or separates; pink tights  
SHOES:

[tap] any black "mary jane" style; buckle or velcro strap

[ballet] any pink; leather full sole ballet slipper; capezio make

### Musicals for Minis & Rhyme in Time

Attire: any dance leo/dress or separates; pink tights

Shoes: any pink; leather full sole ballet slipper; capezio make

### Pre-Ballet

Attire: black dance leo/dress or separates; pink tights

Shoes: : any pink; leather full sole ballet slipper; capezio make

### Boys Classes-

[Tap] Attire: plain t-shirt; black dance pant or sweat pant; no jeans

Shoes: any black; lace up or slip on tap shoe; prefer capezio or bloch make

[Hip Hop] Attire: plain t-shirt; black dance pant or sweat pant; no jeans

Shoes: any black; dance sneaker/hip hop shoe; no other colors please

### Adult Classes-

#### [Ballet]

Attire: dance leo dress; capri dance pant, tank top or t-shirt; fitness attire; form fitting, not too loose

Shoes: any pink; leather or canvas ballet slipper; don't forget your straps!

#### [Tap]

Attire: fitness attire; dance pant or sweat; tank tops or t-shirts; no jeans

Shoes: :any black; lace up or slip on tap shoe; prefer capezio or bloch make

#### [Hip Hop]

Attire: fitness attire; dance pant or sweat; tank tops or t-shirts; no jeans

Shoes: any dance sneaker/hip hop shoe

#### [Country STEP]

Attire: jeans and t-shirt welcome or fitness attire

Shoes: any dance sneaker; (Shoes: must be able to slide) cowboy hats & boots welcome!

### Tap I, II, III

Attire: any dance leo and tights; capri dance pant or short; tank tops

Shoes: any black; lace up or slip on tap shoe; prefer capezio or bloch make

### Jazz I, II, III

Attire: any dance leo and tights; capri dance pant or short; tank tops

Shoes: slip on jazz boot; caramel; capezio make

### Ballet I, II, III

Attire: any black; dance leo; pink tights; dance skirts & warmers welcome

Shoes: (prefer) pink; leather ballet slipper; style "1 pro" make "sansha"

### Pointe-

Attire: any black; dance leo; pink tights; dance skirts & warmers welcome

Shoes: students will be professionally sized for pointe shoes. Some students may need doctor's note. Please inquire 1 week prior to first class.

### Hip Hop I, II, III

Attire: any dance leo and tights; capri dance pant or short; tank tops or t-shirts

Shoes: any black; dance sneaker/hip hop shoe; no other colors please

### Break-Dance & Street Tricks

Attire: loose fit; dance pants or sweat pant; shirts must be long enough to tuck in; girls: wear a leo underneath if needed. Knee & elbow pads, great for first year students!

Shoes: any dance sneaker/hip hop shoe

### Musical Theatre

Attire: any dance leo and tights; dance shorts; tank tops

Shoes: Grecian sandal; check with your teacher for make & color

### Modern & Lyrical

Attire: any dance leo; convertible tights; dance shorts; tank tops

Shoes: any dance paws; foot undeez; or "pirouette" from capezio

### Tap Troupe

Attire: any dance leo and tights; capri dance pant or short; tank top or t-shirt

Shoes: (prefer) black; "tap flex" slip on boot; bloch make

### Drill Team Style

Attire: any dance leo and tights; capri dance pant or short; tank top or t-shirt

Shoes: please see your teacher on first day of class

### Scottish Highland Dancing

Attire: any black dance leo and tights. Socks - white

Shoe: \$56.00 fitted and purchased through instructor on first day.
