***Installment plan** is broken into nine **EQUAL** installments (Sept-May), due at the first of each month with valid debit or credit card. You may choose to pay each payment with a check, however you must keep a credit/debit card on file in the event timely payment is not received. Otherwise, you will be charged a \$15 late fee and your child will not be allowed to participate until your account is current. Students may be dropped by written request during the year with 30 days notice. NO drops are accepted after May 1, 2012.

PLEASE NOTE:

Installment Plan Option is not a "monthly" payment plan. You are paying 9 EQUAL payments at the first of each month (Sept.- May).

Recital Date is TENTATIVELY scheduled for the 1st or 2nd Saturday in June. There will be a mandatory dress rehearsal on the day before the recital. A **Costume Deposit** of \$60 will be due by **11/30/11**, along with a signed participation contract.

A **Performance Fee** of \$50 per student will be due on **02/15/12**. Each performer will receive a memory book and t-shirt. Adult performers may pay \$25 performance fee if memory book and t-shirt is waived.

Refund policy:

If within your child's first 30 days at Bounce you are not satisfied for any reason, we will cheerfully refund 100% of your tuition for your entire first term. If after your child's first 30 days at Bounce you need to withdraw, we will be more than happy to extend an account credit. Please see office staff for account credit details. All refund requests must be made in writing and within the *current session your child is enrolled*. Refunds and account credits are processed within 30 days of written cancellation. Absolutely NO refunds on punch cards, Costume Fees, Apparel, Performance Fees and/or Dance Team expenses.

Class Descriptions:



Youth Classes—Ages 3-6 yrs (students must be potty-trained).

Mini Mix- I Ages 3-4 (30min), Mini Mix II Ages 4-6 (30min)

Your child can learn the basic fundamentals of Tap and Ballet with a bit of Jazzy fun! This class will also help with self confidence, social interaction and continue to build stellar motor skills! Level I, for the beginner, Ages 3-4. Level II, Ages 4-6 or has completed level I.

Pre-Ballet- Ages 4-6 (45min) - This class is for students choosing to learn the basics of Ballet; including body placement / alignment, learning self discipline and the start of French Terminology.

Foundation Classes

Beginning Ballet (50min) Ages 6-8—Preparatory class for Ballet I and up

Ballet I (50min) Ages 8 and up **Ballet II (60min) 10 and up**

Ballet III/IV (75min) Ages 12 and up

A formal technique class based on a direct style, and using specific methods. Ballet is said to be the core foundation of most other dance genres. This is a great starting block for all kinds of performers. Ballet builds a strong core, as well as toning and flexibility. This style of dance challenges the student mentally and physically; working on discipline, confidence, and grace.

Tap (50min) Ages 6 and up

A Rhythm based class, using formal methods of Tap Dancing. Students will learn how to hold rhythm and form sounds with the metal taps on their feet.

Jazz (50min) Ages 6 and up

As a technique based class, Jazz style blends technique with personality. Students will learn from combinations to jumps and turns, inside practicing coronation and memory skills. Jazz has the perfect mix of focus and fun!

Hip Hop (50min) Ages 6 and up - Co-Ed

A mix of Jazz and Funk together to create this fresh and energetic style of dance. Students will learn dance combinations and appropriate level break and street tricks. Be prepared to get moving, Hip Hop is an upbeat, freestyle blast!

Complex Integrated/Specialty Classes

Lyrical—Ages 10 and up (30min) - An informal but dramatic mix of Ballet, Jazz and emotion. Students will be telling stories through their movements, and rediscovering the foundations of dance technique. Previous dance training is recommended.

Acro—Ages 6 & up (50min)

Acro is an artistic collision of gymnastics and dance. The student will learn basic gymnastics skills and tricks in order to incorporate those skills into dance to bring choreography to the next level. Bare foot—shorts, t-shirt/tank or leotard.

Musical Theatre—Ages 8 & up (50min)

A collaboration of Broadway dance, jazz, and acting to teach students how to create show-stopper performances. Students will be exposed to the music of today's Top 40, as well as the era of Show Tunes.

General Info:

- **All participants must have a parent-signed release form to participate in class.**
- If your child is over 6, you may leave the studio area during class time, as long as the staff has an up-to-date cell phone number
- Children are to be picked up promptly at the end of class
- Tuition and fees must be paid in full prior to recital
- Students should place their belongings in cubby holes upon entering studio lobby
- Children must wait in the studio waiting area until their instructor calls their class to the classroom
- Children are not allowed to be in the gym area or studio when they are not in a supervised class.

CONTRACT

To complete your registration for the Bounce Dance Academy for classes, a contract must be signed. This contract includes details regarding the dress code, general rules, recital expectations and fees and an emergency information form that must be completed before attending classes.

ATTIRE

Students are required to attend classes in proper dance attire and will be dismissed from class if proper attire is not worn. Jewelry is not to be worn. See attached sheet for class specific requirements.

Dance Attire & Shoe Requirements

Mini Mix I/II

Attire: pink or black; dance leo/dress or separates; pink tights

SHOES:

[**tap**] any black "mary jane" style; buckle or velcro strap

[**ballet**] any pink; leather full sole ballet slipper; capezio make

Pre-Ballet and Beginning Ballet

Attire: black dance leo/dress or separates; pink tights

Shoes: : any pink; leather split sole ballet slipper; capezio make

Boys Classes-

[**Tap**] Attire: plain t-shirt; black dance pant or sweat pant; no jeans

Shoes: any black; lace up or slip on tap shoe; prefer capezio or bloch make

[**Hip Hop**] Attire: plain t-shirt; black dance pant or sweat pant; no jeans

Shoes: any black; dance sneaker/hip hop shoe; no other colors please

Adult Classes-

[**Jazz**]

Attire: fitness attire; dance pant or sweat (capri length or shorter); tank tops or t-shirts; no jeans

Shoes: Black Jazz Shoe, capezio or bloch make

[**Tap**]

Attire: fitness attire; dance pant or sweat (capri length or shorter); tank tops or t-shirts; no jeans

Shoes: any black; lace up or slip on tap shoe; prefer capezio or bloch make

[**Acro**]

Attire: shorts with t-shirt/tank or leotard (preferred)

Shoes: barefoot

Tap I, II, III

Attire: any dance leo and tights; capri dance pant or short; tank tops

Shoes: any black; lace up or slip on tap shoe; prefer capezio or bloch make

Jazz I, II, III

Attire: any dance leo and tights; capri dance pant or short; tank tops

Shoes: slip on jazz boot; caramel; capezio make

Ballet I, II, III

Attire: any black; dance leo; pink tights; dance skirts & warmers welcome

Shoes: (prefer) pink; split sole leather ballet slipper; style "1 pro" make "sansha" or equivalent

Pointe-

Attire: any black; dance leo; pink tights; dance skirts & warmers welcome

Shoes: students will be professionally sized for pointe shoes. Some students may need doctor's note. Please inquire 1 week prior to first class.

Hip Hop I, II, III

Attire: any dance leo and tights; capri dance pant or short; tank tops or t-shirts

Shoes: any black; dance sneaker/hip hop shoe; no other colors please

Break-Dance & Street Tricks

Attire: loose fit; dance pants or sweat pant; shirts must be long enough to tuck in; girls: wear a leo underneath if needed. Knee & elbow pads, great for first year students!

Shoes: any dance sneaker/hip hop shoe

Lyrical

Attire: any dance leo; convertible tights; dance shorts; tank tops

Shoes: foot undeez; or "pirouette" from capezio or caramel capezio jazz shoe.

Musical Theatre

Attire: any dance leo and tights; capri dance pant or short; tank tops

Shoes: Grecian sandal, Bloch make, Tan

Scottish Highland Dancing

Attire: any black dance leo and tights. Socks - white
Shoe: \$56.00 fitted and purchased through instructor on first day.
